- Pedagogy

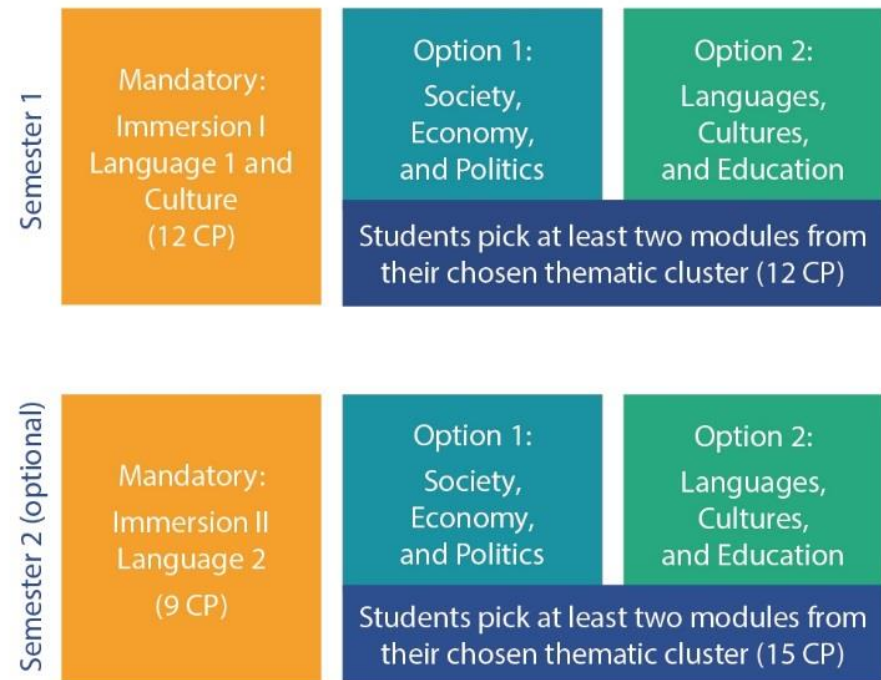
## Course Topics
