



ERRATUM

Erratum to “When genes meet nomenclature: Tortoise phylogeny and the shifting generic concepts of *Testudo* and *Geochelone*”
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In our paper on the shifting generic concepts of *Testudo* and *Geochelone* (Fritz and Bininda-Emonds 2007), we stated on p. 303 that the name *Agrionemys* Khozatsky and Młynarski, 1966 (type species: *Testudo horsfieldii* Gray, 1844) should be used for the clade containing *Testudo hermanni* and *T. horsfieldii* if a subgeneric distinction is to be made for it. However, as pointed out in the same paper, there is another clearly older name available for this clade (i.e., *Chersine* Merrem, 1820; type species: *T. hermanni* Gmelin, 1789) that therefore has priority over and is to be used in place of *Agrionemys*.
