

Study plan and information on module allocation for the Master of Education (M.Ed.) „History“ for higher secondary school education (Gymnasium/Gesamtschule) [Last update: 25/03/2017]

Preliminary remarks:

You either do the specialized internship (module prx530: „Fachpraktikum“) or the research and development internship (module prx536: „Forschungs- und Entwicklungspraktikum“) in the subject area of History (the preparatory course ONLY takes place in the winter term).

Language requirements: Before registering the Master's thesis students have to provide evidence of subject-related knowledge of Latin by passing a written exam in a reading course offered by the Institute of History. The reading course is part of the module ges113 (Ancient History), which takes place in the winter term, and the module ges123 (Medieval History), which takes place in the summer term.
